



- 1. Login Microsoft Online: https://login.microsoftonline.com/common/login
- 2. After Login, Go to SharePoint.




You will see the welcome page:




3. Now Create a Site if you do not have a site yet.




Enter the Site information:




A site is created.



4. Create an Excel File in the SharePoint Site.






If you click on the Excel file, you will see the URL looks like


6. Grant the permission




